Funded by the ERASMUS+ programme, COmmunity ENgagement for Social Inclusion (COMENSI) is a two-year project started in October 2018. We are trying to understand why adults who are living with disadvantage in urban areas are underrepresented in participatory processes and to develop appropriate strategies and tools to counteract such issues.

#### KICK-OFF MEETING (PALERMO, NOV 18)

A chance to put faces to the names, to discuss project implementation details and to create a sense of belonging to the group.

#### ADULT EDUCATORS TRAINING (PALERMO, JUNE 19)

One week of knowledge exchange with 25 adult educators coming from the five EU target neighbourhoods. Together, we learned, discussed and evaluated a range of participatory methods and their effectiveness in creating community engagement.

## COMENSI TOOLKIT

For the past year and a half, we have been researching, designing and testing different ways to engage more people than the 'usual suspects' in civic actions. We have put together a collection of tools, methods and practices specifically designed and selected to improve the engagement of urban communities.

The COMENSI toolkit has been written to support adult education providers, public administration, community managers or professionals interested in activating participatory processes of community engagement in challenging urban settings.



## What will you find in the COMENSI toolkit?

- → The COMENSI method an overarching approach to community engagement to guide projects from the embryonic stage of development through to implementation and evaluation.
- → A collection of engagement methods, tools and techniques to inspire practitioners which includes descriptions, guidelines and practical use examples.
- → Local Framework Scenarios.

# NEIGHBOURHOOD ATLAS

To support the engagement activities deployed in the local labs from five different urban contexts, we have built a digital platform which first prototype is now ready and can be accessed here  $\rightarrow$  <u>https://www.community-atlas.net/</u>

Within the platform, there are five digital atlases which have been specifically designed for each local context made available in the local languages.

## LOCAL LABS

The local labs are the physical -and virtual- community spaces where we are organising different activities to try and understand which are the best methods to engage adults in our neighbourhoods. The virtual side of things is enabled by the Neighbourhood Atlas, the platform built to support and record everything that is happening.

#### AJUDA - LISBOA, PORTUGAL

Purpose: Gather collective memories of the community to promote a sense of belonging to the Ajuda territory and encourage a participatory role in the future. Support local initiatives and ideas to be developed in Ajuda. Actions to date:

- → Create, maintain, strengthen ties and mapping local stakeholders, and the community;
- $\rightarrow$  Labs to collect ideas;

→ Collected inputs for our atlas; Future plans: Adapt and support the local initiatives/ideas possible to adjust to Covid-19 situation in order to improve the community together with other local stakeholders.

### CAPO - MONTE DI PIETÀ' -PALERMO, ITALY

Purpose: to engage the local community in a process of sharing ideas and co-creation of actions of neighbourhood enhancement Actions to date:

- → open meetings and volunteering actions to start the process;
- → creation of the network of local stakeholders and administrators from the City Council;
- → collection of ideas and initiatives with the residents & atlas update

Future plans: after the Covid-19 emergency decrease, we will continue the co-creation process with the residents and the meetings with the local network. If possible, and if still valid, we will execute some of the ideas emerged in the previous months and realise neighbourhood events.

## LOCAL LABS

#### **MEHRINGPLATZ - BERLIN, GERMANY**

Purpose: Mapping and networking community initiatives and hubs Actions to date: 4 thematic laboratories on **delimitations**, **places**, **memories**, and **transformations** collected inputs for our atlas. Resulting data are being published online in the *Atlas of the Südliche Friedrichstadt*.

Future plans: to select a range of "stories of engagement" documenting local initiatives and projects mobilising the neighbourhood and improving civic participation. Working remotely with the participants to the lab to complete the atlas and prepare the scripts of the stories of engagement. These stories will be the object of the next lab in May dedicated to digital storytelling and published on the atlas.
